

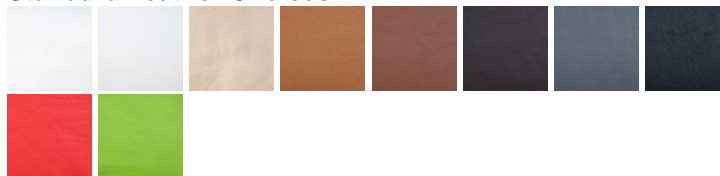
Mies van der Rohe Style: Flat Arm Side Chair

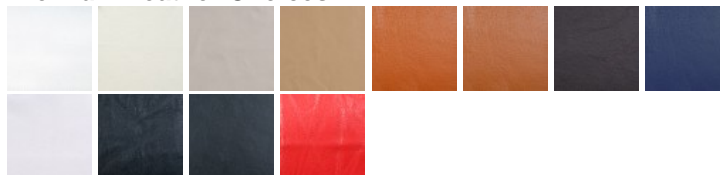

DESCRIPTION

Our Mies Executive Flat Arm Side Chair was inspired by the chair originally designed in 1930 for the Tugendhat House in Brno, Czechoslovakia. Known around the world as the "Brno Chair", to this day it is an elegant and luxurious design suitable for the dining room, office seating or waiting room.

We make our Executive Flat Arm Side Chair using only the high quality 12mm flat stock 304 stainless steel polished to a mirror-like finish. Our upholstery is top-grain leather imported from Italy. Excellent sewing detail is maintained on the all the chair seams. The seat cushions are high resilient - high density polyurethane foam over an internal spring suspension. You will note that our seat backs and bottom also have a flat, sleek look.

Chairs may be ordered with or without the arm pads in matching leather, which adds about a quarter inch to the arm height. Please specify if you would like matching leather armpads when ordering. Note: Not all photos show the armpads. Shown here in Premium Honey Tan leather.

LEATHER CHOICES

Modern Classics Furniture purchases leather from a variety of tanneries in order to provide our own collection of colors. Not all leathers are available for use on all products. Each product in our catalog will indicate which leather is available for that piece of furniture. We have divided our leather selections into two groups, Standard and Premium with different price levels within each group. All the leathers we offer feature:

- Top-grain leather from Grade A hides
- Smooth or Textured, depending on the color
- Vegetable Drum Dyed with Moisture and UV protection built into the dye
- Made in Italy and imported to our factory
- No split hides or bonded leather
- Leather thickness is generally 1.0 - 1.2 mm

All our leathers are considered equally durable and are ideal for home or commercial use. To read more about leather, read our [A Guide to Understanding Upholstery Leather: A Primer](#). Below are the color swatches of the leather colors we offer, along with price level, Level 1 being the lowest cost and Level 4 being the highest cost. Not all leathers are offered on all products and have varying price levels, so please refer to each individual product page for which leathers are applicable. Our **Standard Leathers** (denoted with the prefix L1) are top-grain, aniline-dyed, and then color corrected with a slight embossing to create a more uniform grain pattern. Our **Premium leathers** (denoted with the prefix L2) are also top-grain, aniline-dyed but have a soft feel to them and much of the hides natural grain patterns are retained.
